Overall Survey Results

We are excited to share with you the results of the ChairWorld survey. Chairs responded and shared the following feedback:

- Overall Satisfaction with the event: 4.7 (Increased from 4.64 last year)
- Overall, how effective was the event content in fostering Chair development & collaboration: 4.7 (Increased from 4.62 last year)
- Relevance of breakout topics to meet your immediate Chair practice interests & needs: 4.7 (Increased from 4.49 last year)
- The quality and value of takeaways in the art & business of Chairing: 4.7 (Increased from 4.57 last year)
- How likely are you to attend this event in 2016? 4.7 (Increased from 4.65 last year)
